Commencement Materials



Commencement Pack: Your Commencement Pack includes your cap and gown, mortar board, and tassel.

The Commencement Pack (including shipping) is free for all Fall 2024, Spring 2025, and Summer 2025 graduates, but you will need to place the order yourself at www.Jostens.com.

Please note that any additional items such as announcements, stoles, and accessories, are NOT included in your Commencement Pack and costs for those items are your responsibility.



Remember to place your order for the Commencement Pack by April 9th, 2025.



Your cap and gown, included in your Commencement Pack, are required to participate in the Commencement exercises.

Tickets: Each student will receive five (5) tickets. These tickets are required for entry into the Masonic Auditorium. Each student is allotted only five tickets; no additional tickets can be provided by the University.

Announcements*: Graduation announcements are available through www.Jostens.com. You are responsible for the cost of any announcements you order.



***Please be aware that graduation announcements are not the same as graduation invitations/tickets. Announcements cannot be used for admission to the Commencement ceremony.**

Diplomas: Diplomas will be mailed to graduates approximately 90 days after all coursework has been completed and grades have been posted. Please verify that your address is correct on the student self-service portal.

Arrival



Graduates: You must check in **TWO HOURS** before the start of your ceremony! Therefore, please allow plenty of time for travel, drop off, parking, etc. If you arrive less than two hours prior to your ceremony, you run the risk of not walking with your department. Commencement ceremonies are complex and highly coordinated events; **please don't be late!**

Be sure to hand off your tickets to your family/friends before entering the facility.

Guests: Please let your guests know the exact time for their arrival: 9:00 AM for the Undergraduate ceremony and 2:00 PM for the Graduate ceremony. Guests will not be allowed to enter the auditorium any earlier than one hour before each ceremony.

Check-In

Once again: check-in is required **TWO HOURS** prior to your ceremony! Undergraduate Students should be at the Masonic by 8:00 AM; Graduate Students should be at the Masonic by 1:00 PM. Please plan accordingly.



Please follow the signs to the check-in and line-up area on California Street. You will be looking for signs that read "EXHIBIT HALL."



Please note that you will be looking for the entrance by the parking garage and NOT the main entrance of the auditorium at the top of the steps.

It is important to be punctual so that we can verify your attendance. You are required to check in at the student check-in table for your major. **Your name will not be called if you do not check in and collect your index card.**

You will then line up with your fellow students in your department or program.

We will provide hangers and coat racks for you to store your personal belongings in the graduate check-in and lineup area. While this area will be cordoned off from public access, the Academy is not liable for the loss of personal belongings.

Parking and Transportation

Parking is available for \$35 - \$50 per car at the venue.

Campus shuttles will also be available, running on a continuous loop from campus to the event venue for students and guests. The venue is accessible via public transportation. We suggest using [Google maps](#) or [511.org](#) to find the best route for your visit.

Commencement Ceremony Details



The Procession: The procession will be led by the Master of Ceremonies.

All graduating students will march into the auditorium in celebration of their Commencement. Graduates remain standing for the entire processional.

Recognition of Graduating Students: Per Academy tradition, each graduate's name will be read aloud, at which time that student will walk across the stage.

Each graduate will be presented with a diploma cover, and each graduate will be photographed by a professional photographer. Please be respectful of the ceremony and your fellow students and refrain from taking "selfies" while on stage.

Out of respect for all participants, graduates must stay throughout the entire ceremony and must remain seated unless otherwise directed by faculty marshals.

The Recessional: After all students have been recognized, President Stephens and other University executives will recess first, followed by faculty members. Finally, the graduates exit, beginning with the front row and followed by each succeeding row.

Behavior and Line up Information: Commencement is a dignified occasion. Participants are expected to conduct themselves accordingly. The behavior of each graduate helps to set the tone for this important event. Graduates and families look forward to this milestone with excitement and anticipation. For many guests, Commencement is their first experience with the Academy. We want to ensure that the Commencement ceremony elicits positive memories for all who attend. Students and guests are expected to remain seated until the ceremony has concluded.

After the Ceremony: Graduates are asked to meet their family members and guests at a pre-determined (by you) location outside. If family members or guests wish to present you with flowers, please ask them to do so after the ceremony.

Guidelines for Guests



Protocol: Commencement marks the pinnacle of academic achievement, and the Academy proudly celebrates the occasion with formal pomp and circumstance. Please help us provide a memorable event for all involved.

- *To be considerate of other guests and graduates we ask that your guests do not bring noise makers, utilize umbrellas, or stand in the aisles during the Commencement Ceremony.*
- *Each guest must have a ticket for entry.*
- *Guests should be seated before the procession begins; late arrivals will have to wait until the procession ends.*
- *Cell phones and electronic devices should be placed on silent mode.*
- *Guests are asked to remain for the entire ceremony as a sign of respect for all graduates.*

Photos and Videos: Audience members are welcome to take photographs and videos throughout the ceremony, provided they remain in their seats, do not block aisles or egresses, and do not block the views of other guests.

Prohibited Items: The following items are prohibited: alcohol; illegal drugs/paraphernalia; weapons of any kind, including firearms and knives; and animals (certified service animals are allowed). Balloons, air horns, and other decorations or noisemakers are not allowed at the venue. Please leave these items at home or in your vehicle. Security will be screening guests upon entry to the venue.
