Refund Policy:

- The Student Fee is fully refundable up until 1 month before the program check-in date. (MAY 26, 2022)
- The Student Fee is refundable 50% up until 2 weeks before the program check-in date (JUNE 12, 2022) after which time there will be no refunds for any fees.
- · Housing Fees, based on student requests, are non-refundable after the SRISA Program Deadline.
- Housing Deposits for all participants are non-refundable until the end of the program. They will then be reimbursed, minus any damages or incurred expenses, in the form of a check in US Dollars approximately 3 months after the end of your program.
